Horsemanship Education Course: Groundwork and Round Pen Training

April 27-May 1 & May 4-8

ProTrack™: Groundwork and Round Pen Training

May 11-15

This two-week ground training course may be taken independently, or as part of the complete course and consists of all aspects of groundwork. You will be taught to use the horse's natural characteristics to teach the following:

Round Pen Work: Teaches the horse to focus on you, start under saddle, break bad habits, or adjust attitude to become a willing partner.

Spook Training: Teaches the horse to stop his feet and look at whatever is scaring him, rather than spinning around or bolting away

V.S.S. A "Very Special Safety" lesson, which teaches directional control on the lead rope, to stand quietly, to respect your space, not to run into or over you and to develop the horse's attention span.

Trailer Loading: To teach the horse to go into the trailer safely and calmly and to unload in a slow, relaxed manner.

Sacking out: Desensitizes the horse to all the things that he will encounter on a daily basis; your hands, blankets, bridles, saddles, ropes etc.

Also – ÷ you will learn how to teach halter breaking, advanced leading, first time mounting, what to do on your first rides, getting the horse comfortable with a rider, and more...

Horsemanship Education Course: Basic Under Saddle Training

ProTrack™: Basic Under Saddle Training

June 22-26

All aspects of a horse's basic "under saddle" education will be addressed in this session. This includes how to develop balance, control and suppleness at the walk, trot and canter, lateral work, introduction to trails and trail obstacles, and much more. You will learn Bob's "*Partnership Training for Horse and Rider*" System® of gaining control of the horse's individual body parts enabling you to teach directional control, giving to the bit and direct reining, stopping, go cue, backing, etc. Suzanne will introduce points of equitation and Centered Riding® which improve your equestrian technique, balance, quality of communication and control with lots of supportive feedback and specific exercises to improve effectiveness.

Horsemanship Education Course: Advanced Under Saddle Training

ProTrack™ : Advanced Under Saddle Training

July 27-31

This is where our "trail safe" horse begins the transformation to "performance level horse". You shall learn techniques to teach more balanced cantering, circles, leads, leg and seat cues, collection, neck reining (if desired), side passing, correct backing, advanced stops, turns on forehand, spins or turns on the haunches, and more sophisticated lateral work. Suzanne will teach more in-depth Centered Riding® instruction to enhance performance and cut your training time. The program is easily adaptable to either English or Western Riding.

Upon completion of all three sessions you will be a graduate of our program. We offer our additional ProTrack courses for those individuals interested in becoming candidates for certification.

Hello Fellow Horseperson,

Let us take the opportunity to congratulate you on your decision to attend our 2009 Horsemanship Education Courses and/or ProTrack™ Horse Trainer Certification Program. We realize this is a significant investment of time and money on your part. Please know that we shall do our very best to ensure that you understand the lessons and get the results you desire. You can either bring one horse (trained or untrained) of your own or you can use one of ours, which you shall train. You will also be able to work with other horses if you so desire in order to get a feel for the various reactions of different horses. While this is mandatory only for ProTrack students, we highly recommend it for all.

In addition to your Coggins you will also need a lariat (30 feet is the best size and either a medium or soft lay), saddle blanket, saddle, bridle, bit, halter, lead rope (10-12 foot cotton) and a 4-foot dressage whip. For your convenience, these items are all available for purchase at the ranch. You must feed your own horses, but we have hay for sale if it's more convenient than bringing your own. Be sure that your horse's teeth have been recently floated, his hooves shod (very rocky terrain here!), and that he/she is physically ready to work.

The cost of the program is \$1,350 per week, and you can either bring your own horse or use one of ours.

A negative Coggins (drawn within the 12 months prior to the sessions being) attended is required for admittance. A limited number of participants are accepted in order to maintain a small teacher/student ratio allowing for personalized instruction.

PLEASE NOTE: You do not need to take all sessions in the same year. You do, however, need to take "Basic Under Saddle Training" session before taking the "Advanced Under Saddle Training" session.

From I-84

Take exit 4W onto Route 17 West. Take exit 120 (Middletown/Montgomery Rt. 211). Turn right at traffic light at end of exit ramp onto Route 211 East. At second traffic light turn left onto Blumel Road (you will see Rite Aid Pharmacy at this intersection). Refer to * below.

From Route 17 East

Take exit 120 (Middletown/Montgomery Route 211), go under overpass. At the 3rd traffic light turn left onto Blumel Road (Rite Aid Pharmacy is on the left at this intersection). Refer to * below.

From New York State Thruway

Take exit 16. Go through the toll booth onto Route 6West/17 West. Continue to exit 120 (Middletown/Montgomery Route 211). Turn right at traffic light at end of ramp onto Route 211 East. At the second traffic light turn left onto Blumel Road (Rite Aid Pharmacy is on the left at this intersection). Refer to * below.

*You will go up a hill and continue straight through the traffic light. At this point the name of the road changes to Scotchtown/Collabar Road/County Route 47. Continue on for about 2 more miles from the traffic light and turn right onto Tamms Road. Go to the top of the hill. Turn left into the third driveway, 168 Tamms Road. Drive past the house to the barn.
